## IV. Pottery with Mrs. Mason and Mrs. Peterson

**Instructo**r: Bev Mason

Assistant: Chelsea Peterson

Mrs. Mason is a former school teacher and has developed her skills and passion over the years as a local



ceramic artist and pottery teacher. Bev works out of a community pottery studio in Delta with the North Delta Potters Guild. Her ceramic creations are both functional and fanciful, representing a variety of ceramic and glazing techniques. She currently exhibits her work locally in Watershed Artworks Gift and Gallery Shop at the North Delta Rec Centre.

Mrs. Peterson, who frequently assists in her pottery classes, will also be instructing and helping alongside Mrs. Mason.

Time: 12:45-2:15

Cost: \$95 per student (4 students min. class size, all grades are welcome!)

Students will explore their creative side as they learn about the fundamentals of working with the medium of clay. Using basic hand tools, students will discover a variety of techniques to shape, sculpt, build with and join clay pieces together. Students will also have opportunity to learn the basic processes (drying, bisque firing, and glazing) required to finish clay into functional and decorative pottery. All clay, tools and firing costs are included. Clay easily washes from hands and clothing with water. All projects will be available to take home one week after the last session.
