Students who are gifted have varying individual needs, experiences, aptitudes and interests. Programs for students who are gifted often require a blend of opportunities both in the school and in the community. The more extraordinary the ability of the student, the more necessary it becomes to expand the available options.

There are some common elements which characterize an individualized program appropriate for a student who is gifted:

- it is different in pace, scope and complexity, in keeping with the nature and extent of the exceptionality;
- it provides opportunities for students to interact socially and academically with both age peers and peers of similar abilities;
- it addresses both the cognitive and affective domains;
- it incorporates adaptations and/or extensions to content, process, product, pacing and learning environment; and

 it goes beyond the walls of the school and into the wider community.

We believe that gifted children should be accelerated in areas that they show exceptionality, have plenty of different types of enrichment and have a broad education with many options.

OUR MISSION

Tuition Assistance Program

WHAT IS A TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM?

There are financial obligations when a family sends their child to an independent or private, non-public school. The primary expense is tuition, payments which go to support the cost of teachers, supplies and facilities. Families whose current financial circumstances may not support the payment of the various fees required to enroll in Choice School are encouraged to make an application for support under the School's Tuition Assistance Program. The School seeks students whose families are committed to the vision of the school and to using their own resources to make this education their top priority. Our School will act as partners with your family to discover what resources are available to enable you to give the gift of private education to your child.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- 1. The Student must be enrolled in and be accepted into Choice School.
- 2. The application and corresponding documentation must be supplied to the School's external provider, Apple Financial Services at https://www.applefinancialservices.ca/apply/index.php.
- 3. The School's Principal receives the results from Apple and processes the application.
- 4. New student applicants will be notified of the results of their application within two weeks of

- receipt by Choice School from Apple of the results of their application.
- 5. Returning students, who have made application by the end of February, will be notified of the status of their application by early April.

LEVELS OF ASSISTANCE

There are four levels of Tuition Assistance available to families who qualify. They are:

- 10% of annual tuition fees
- 20% of annual tuition fees
- 35% of annual tuition fees
- 50% of annual tuition fees

- Wage Support: copies of last year's T4s,
- Government Notices: Revenue
 Canada Notices of Assessment,
- Self Employed: If you are a selfemployed person, a copy of Schedule 2125
- Companies: If you are incorporated the most recent set of Financial Statements
- Rental Income
